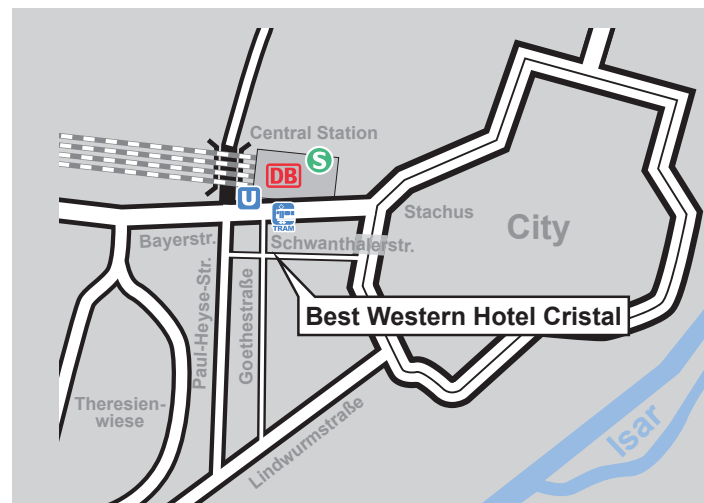

WELCOME

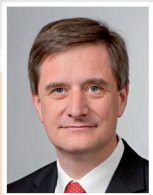
Dear Colleagues,
